MRS Jellyfish

Overview

I.M.R. has been hired by a biological research company to interfere in the operations of a competitor. Sequim Marine Research Laboratories, Anders Island site, are performing research in manipulating the acid production of Jellyfish on behalf of a subsidiary of [REDACTED].

It is believed that this research may have results in the defence industry.

Our task is to delay this research. If possible, to steal it for our employer. Work has already been ongoing on the former task.

Goals

- 0. Maintain I.M.R. and the customers plausible deniability for any translegal activities.
- 1. Low casualties. No corpses.
- 2. Delay the progress of the research substantially.
- 3. Retrieve the research.
- 4. Put a stop to this line of research entirely. (Note: Anders Island may not be the only site)

Situation Report

Sequim are due to deliver a status report to their employers [REDACTED] in two months. It is required that this report indicate little or no progress. (Goal 2)

This is considered a safe zone and suitable for light operations (surveillance and extraction without backup)

We currently have no active forces in this theatre.

We currently have no passive forces in this area.

Our estimated air response time is forty minutes.

Our estimated land/sea response time is three hours.

Forces in the Region

Sequim have 13 (thirteen) employees at this site, of whom only 3 (three) are security staff.

Anders Island itself has only a population of a hundred.

The local police force is 4 (four) of whom 3 (three) are active. They have light arms available.

The local organised criminal element is estimated at 4 (four). There may be light arms available.

The coastguard response time is estimated at thirty minutes - they have speed boats and medium arms available.

Budget Report

To this point it was not deemed commercially viable to assign a strike team to this mission. We believe that simple commercial interference would be sufficient to achieve goals zero one and two.

However, combined with the training needs of Squad C this situation has changed. We therefore now intend to achieve goal three and possibly also goal four.

Funding will be supplied from the training budget: 1RP per trainee plus 3 to cover. Green flag transport to and from the site can be provided outside of this, dark-light can be provided against this budget if the team requests.

Backup will be on standby, as per normal training procedures.
